

DUNEDIN BRANCH PHOTO COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. This competition is being administered by the Institution of Professional Engineers New Zealand trading as Engineering New Zealand whose registered office is at Level 6, 40 Taranaki Street, Te Aro, Wellington, 6011.
2. By entering this competition members indicate their agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
3. The competition is only open to members of Engineering New Zealand who currently reside in the Dunedin region. Current Dunedin Branch Committee members and employees of Engineering New Zealand and their Immediate Families are excluded from the competition. Immediate Families include spouses, grandparents, parents, children, and grandchildren.
4. Entry is free. Members may enter up to two categories (1 photo per category). Multiple entries will be disregarded.
5. Engineering New Zealand accepts no responsibility for any entries not received for whatever reason.
6. All entries remain the property of the member.
7. By entering the competition, winners agree to their names and photographs being published in the Dunedin Branch Newsletter.
8. Photos are to be taken after 16 August 2022.
9. Categories for the competition are:
 - i. engineering heritage
 - ii. engineering in nature
 - iii. engineering in action
 - iv. engineering in community
10. The Dunedin Branch committee will select the winning photos. Entries will be judged at the sole discretion of the committee, but the following criteria will be considered:
 - i. uniqueness and complexity of the related engineering concept in the photo,
 - ii. the relationship presented in the photo between the engineering concept and the category;
 - iii. inspiration;
 - iv. humor.

11. The prize is one \$50 Prezzy™ card for each category. The prize is not redeemable for cash or transferable. An additional \$50 Prezzy™ card will be awarded to the “People’s Choice” winner chosen on the evening when the category winners are announced.
