Observations

1.	Reinforcing is as per drawings, hooks connecting into existing wall yet to be installed but holes have been drilled. Holes consistently to 150mm depth. Photos to be sent when hooks installed.
2.	Concrete nib wall reinforcing has been completed as per drawings. Contractor to chemset 4 starter bars into concrete foundation to stop cage moving during pour. Send through photos of installed bars pre-pour.
3.	Contractor wants to know if wall can be sprayed in one continuous go or if it needs to be built up. Will confirm with director and email contractor.

Actions required

1.	Take photos when hooks have been installed into existing wall and send through, pre-pour approval required.
2.	Engineer to confirm via email whether ok to spray wall in one continuous pour.
3.	Send through photos of chemset bars to secure cage.
