

Covid-19 Student Survey.

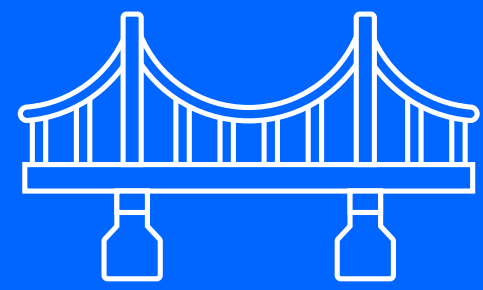

Here are the results.

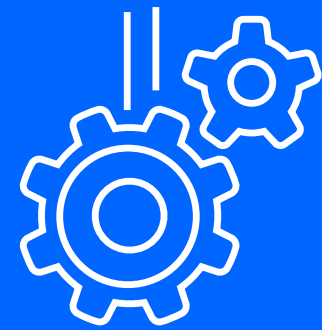

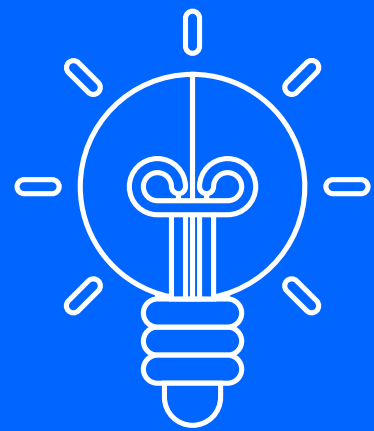
RESPONSES FROM A WIDE RANGE OF ENGINEERING FIELDS.



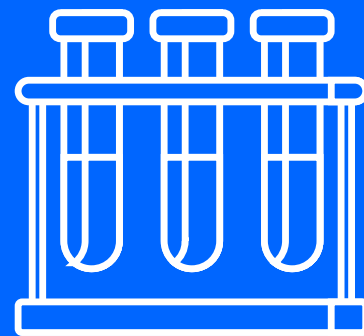

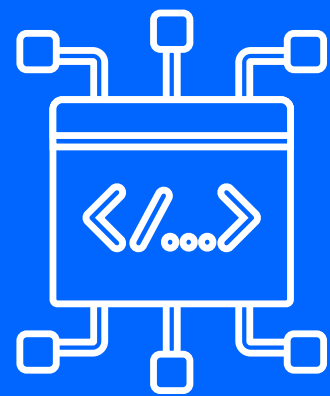

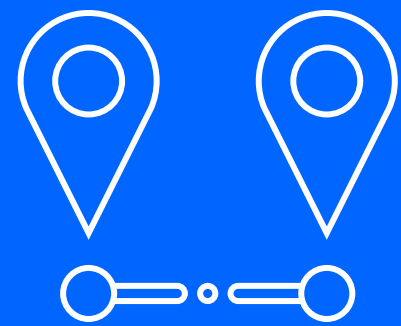

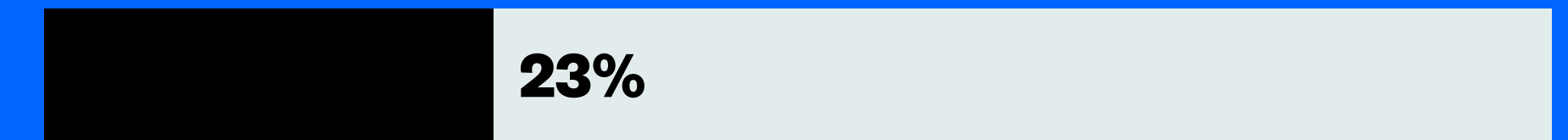

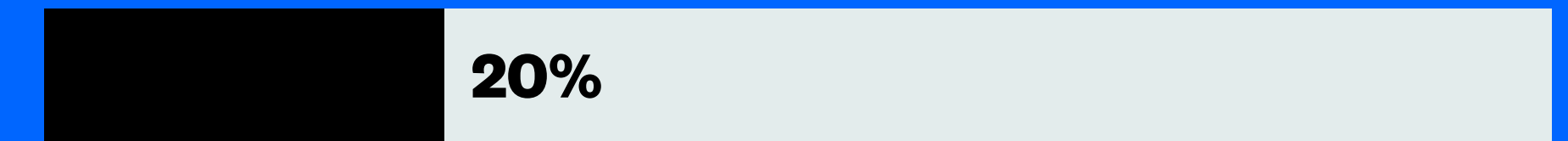

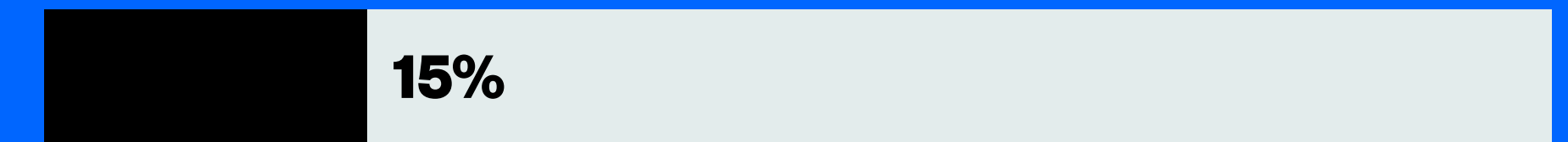

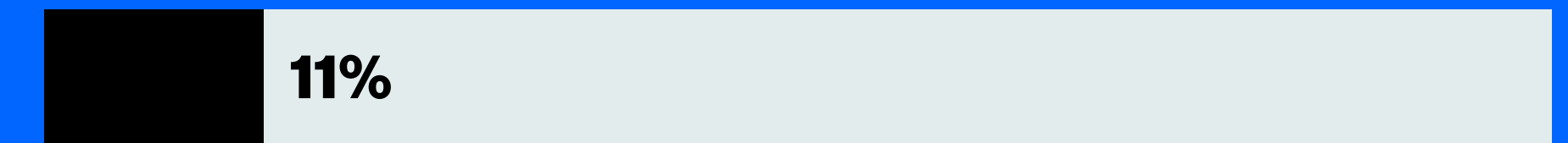

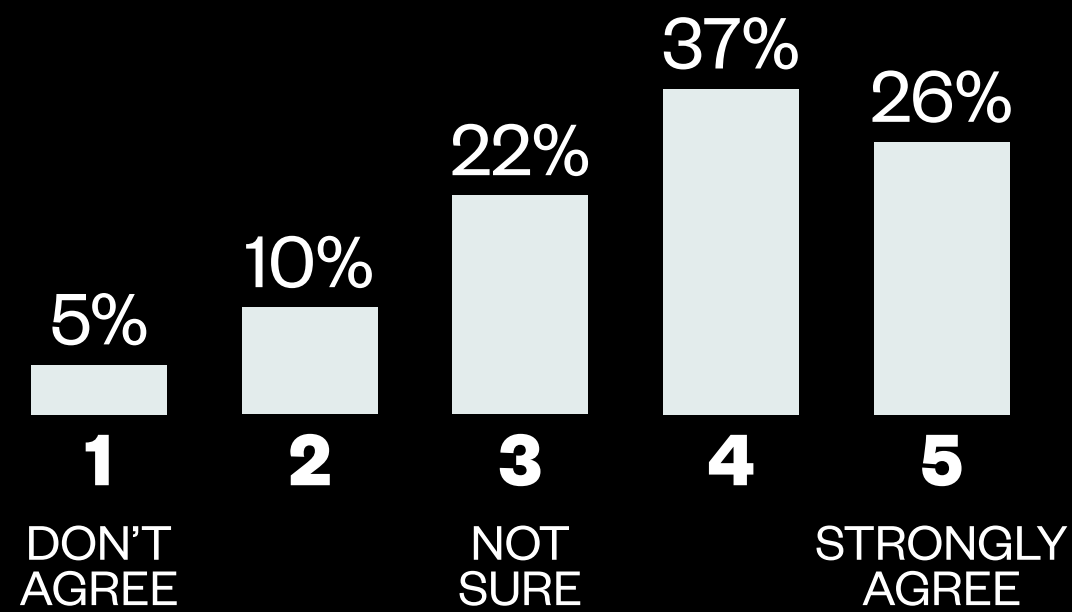

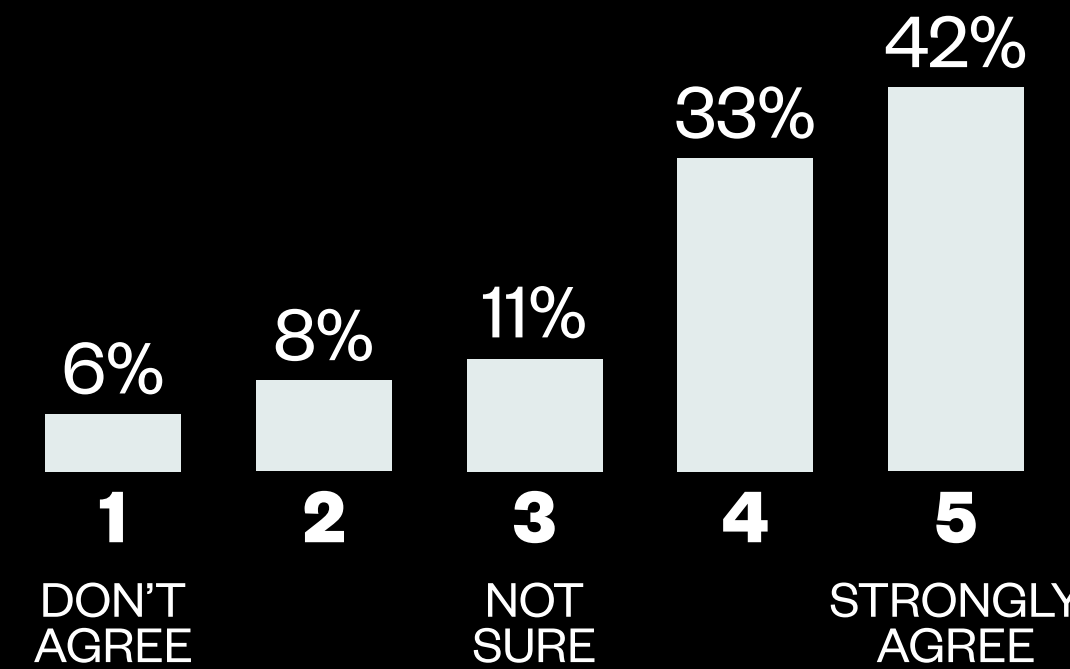

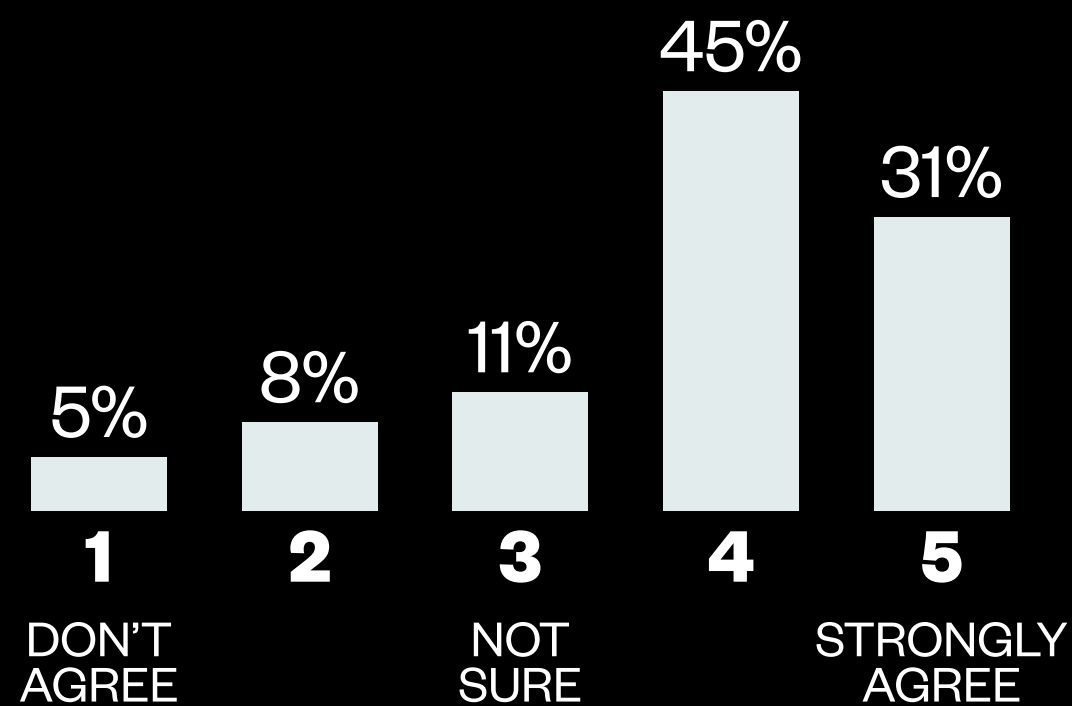

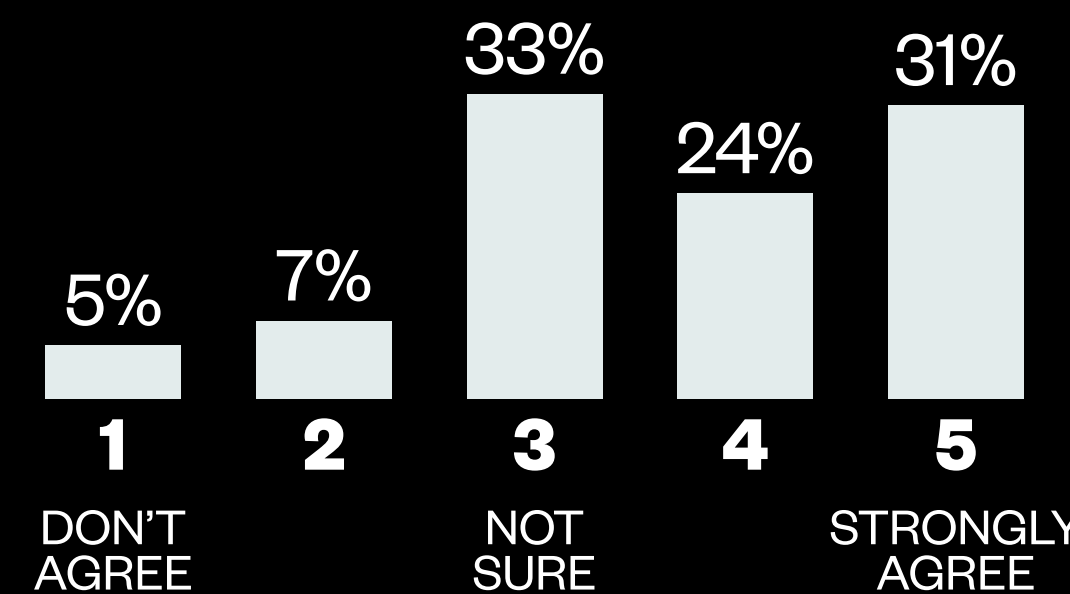

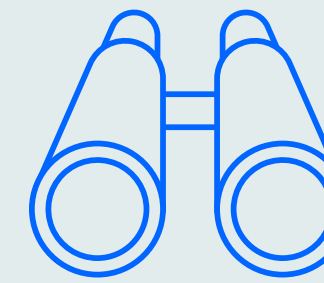

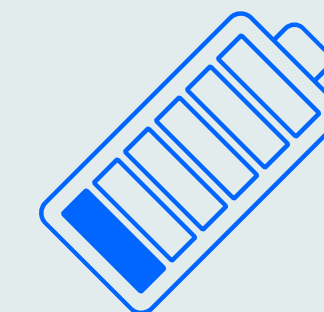
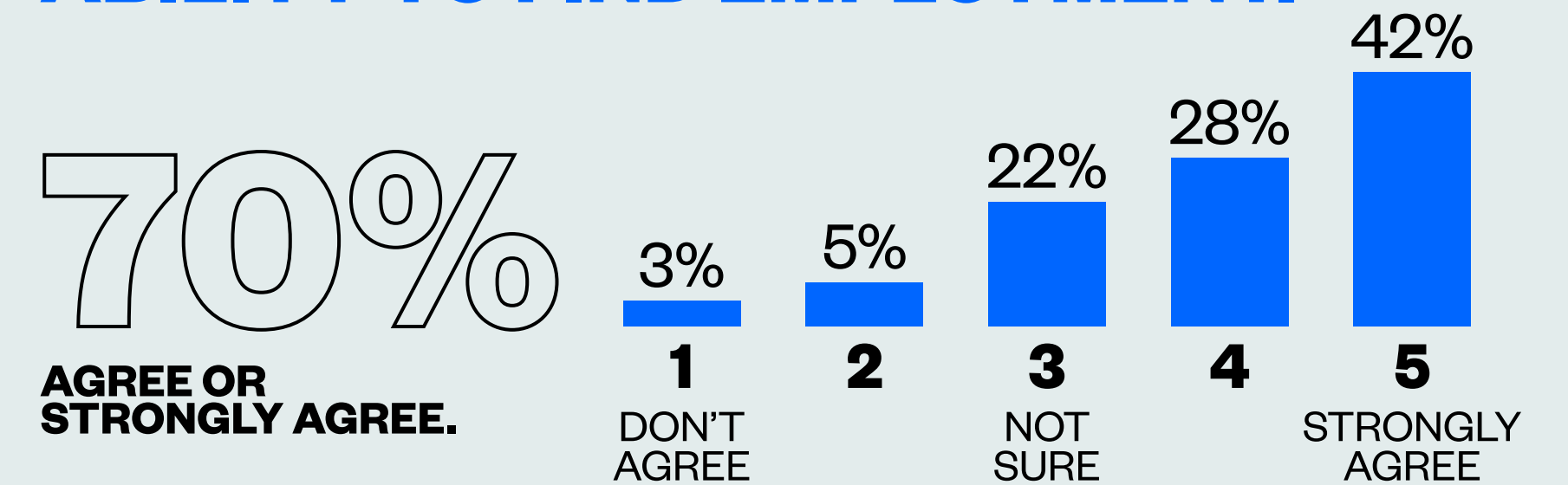
